## Five Year Strategic Plan 2017-2018 through 2022-2023

#### **GOAL**

Evolve an enhanced and greater visibility of Rotary 5320 activities within the local communities, leading to strengthening and growth of clubs and their membership; encouraging likeminded people to get involved in helping others.

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

## 1) Support and Strengthen Clubs (Membership)

- Encourage established clubs to utilize the COL changes to establish satellite groups and accept alternative meeting times and simplified meeting protocols;
- Encourage at least 5 clubs to join in the Zone led consistency program for the next three years.
- Establish new clubs to enhance service to existing and new potential members;
  - Consider specialty interests such as ecology or peace clubs;
  - Increase total District membership by a net of 50 new members annually;

# 2) Support and strengthen District Leadership through evolution of training programs;

- Broaden concept of leadership to include business and community service;
- Increase Youth Exchange to at least 2 outgoing and two incoming foreign exchange students annually;
- Re-energize mentorship programs within clubs;

### 3) Enhance Public Image and Awareness

- Encourage clubs to update (standardized) websites more frequently (link to club recognition);
- Encourage increased Facebook presence as well as Tweets and other options;
  - Encourage intra-club cooperation (Leadership Forum);
  - Utilize new Rotary branding more effectively (example);
  - Train members in social communication to drive opinion-making and awareness of Rotary;
  - Make the Rotary story simpler, clearer and more exciting to encourage interest from our target markets;

### 4) Focus and Increase Humanitarian Service

- Enhance DDF and Global Grant training to aid clubs increase the value of potential projects (modified for immediate past DDF & GG training);
- Utilize the substantial amount of video and other materials available to stimulate increased awareness of the diversity of projects locally and globally which Rotary TRF is involved in;
- Implement Leadership forums to facilitate and encourage clubs collaborating on project opportunities locally and globally;

#### **Tactics include:**

- Develop a District Ambassadors program to communicate with companies and non-profits (Can we get membership of ONEOC?)
- Encourage increased membership of the PHS;
